WHITE WINE / ALENTEJO REGIONAL WINE

- GRAPE VARIETIES:** 100% Arinto, 30 years old vineyards.
- VINTAGE:** The year was marked by some temperatures and precipitations fluctuations, being a hot and dry year. The weather remained stable allowing a very good health of the vines. Very fresh wines are expected, with good acidity, good aromatic intensity, elegance and balance.
- CLIMATE:** Typically Mediterranean with a strong continental influence and huge temperature variations. The region's dry hot summer days and cool nights contribute to the perfect maturation of the grapes and quality of the wines.
- SOIL:** Poor soils, dominated by limestone, perfect to produce fresh, mineral and structured wines.
- VINIFICATION:** Manual harvest. Carefully selected grapes at the harvesting and in the cellar. Gentle pressing, only separating the free-run juice from the must. The fermentation took place in new oak barrels (50%) in a cold chamber at controlled temperature at 14°C and in stainless steel tanks (50%) at 16°C, with ageing on fine lees for 10 months.
- TASTING NOTES:** White wine with a clear and citrine colour. On the nose the wine shows a citric and floral character, on the palate there is a great integration between acidity and wine body, supported by quality barrels. A wine with a long finish.
- Consume preferably at 10°C-12°C.
